Audio books for those with reading impairments. Experience books using a computer, smartphone or tablet.

Borrow digital audio books via Legimus

If you are entitled to borrow audio books, you can download these yourself from Legimus.

Staff at your local library will help you to register an account with Legimus. Users under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a legal guardian during registration. You do not need to state the nature of your reading impairment.

Legimus on your smartphone or tablet

Download the Legimus app. This is available for both iPhone/iPad and Android devices.

Once you've logged in to your account, the app enables you to easily download and listen to audio books straight away.

Legimus on your computer

By visiting legimus.se, you can easily listen to books directly in your computer's browser. By clicking on the "Läs nu" link displayed next to the book, it will open in the Legimus player.

Who is entitled to use Legimus?

If you need a printed book to be adapted in some way so that you are able to read it, you are entitled to borrow books from Legimus.

Examples of the forms of reading impairments that entitle you to borrow audio books include:

- Reading and writing difficulties
- Visual impairment
- Other physical impairments or disabilities
- Intellectual impairments or disabilities
- Neuropsychiatric impairments or disabilities

You are also entitled to borrow audio books if your impairment is only temporary. You will receive a temporary Legimus account from your local library.

If Swedish is not your native language

If Swedish is not your native language, this does not count as a reading impairment. If, however, you also experience difficulties reading in your native language, you are entitled to borrow audio books (both in Swedish and in other languages).
