Welcome to the V8 Libraries

Eight libraries – one library card

Dorotea, Lycksele, Malå, Norsjö,
Sorsele, Storuman, Vilhelmina
and Åsele

**Borrow, return and reserve items
at whichever library you wish
– using the same library card!**

Your library card

In order to borrow anything from the library, you must have a library card. This can be obtained by presenting a valid form of identification (including a photograph). You must also agree to comply with the rules for borrowing that apply at the V8 Libraries.

Children can receive a library card from the year of their 6th birthday.

You must have your library card with you whenever you wish to borrow an item. The library card is valid for all libraries included in the V8 collaboration.

Your personal data

Information about your current loans and reservations will be registered in a common computer system shared by the V8 Libraries. This means that library staff are able to access data that is protected by the Public Access to Information and Secrecy Act (OSL). All staff at the libraries are bound by an obligation of confidentiality, in accordance with chapter 40, § 3 of OSL.

You are responsible for your loans

A library card represents a binding form of documentation, which means that you are responsible for books and any other items that are borrowed using your card.

Parents or legal guardians are responsible for a child's loans. If you should lose your card, you must inform the library as quickly as possible so that the card can be blocked for further use. If another person borrows items using your card, you may be liable to pay for replacement/compensation. A new library card costs 10 kr.

Borrowing period

The borrowing period varies depending on the item that is being borrowed. The return date is displayed on your receipt for the loan and on your account at v8biblioteken.se.

You are responsible for ensuring that your borrowed items are returned by the correct date.

If items are not returned by the end of the borrowing period, you must pay a fee for late return. No late-return fee is payable for items for children, nor for loans made to children.

Renew a loan

If you would like to renew a loan, you can do so at v8biblioteken.se

You can also call or visit the library and ask the staff for help. If you renew a loan after the end of the borrowing period, you must pay a late-return fee. If the borrowing period has expired, or if another user has reserved the item, it will not be possible for you to renew the loan.

Late returns

If a borrowed item has still not been returned after two reminders have been sent, you will be sent an invoice and your library card will be blocked for further use. The card will be unblocked when the item has been returned or the invoice has been paid.

Invoices that apply to children (under 18 years) will be sent to the child's parent/legal guardian.

Reservations

You can reserve a book that is currently being borrowed by another user or that is located at another of the V8 Libraries. You will receive a message when the book is ready to be collected.

You can make your reservation either at your local library or at v8biblioteken.se

Fees

It does not cost anything to borrow an item! The library will, however, impose a fee for any item that is not returned in time.

Borrowing period 28 days: 1 kr/day

Borrowing period 14 days: 5 kr/day

You are liable to pay any late-return fee from (and including) the day of your 18th birthday. No late-return fees are applied to children's books.

The library will impose a fee for any items that are not returned or that are damaged. In either event, this is subject to the library's judgement, and the size of the fee may vary.

PIN code

Your library card is protected by a PIN code. You can use this code to log in to the library's website. Once logged in, you can renew a loan, reserve an item, borrow digital media and search the databases. Your PIN code also enables you to use the self-service borrowing machines in your library.
